Finally, in collaboration with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), PPSAT reached out to the clients of the Lualhati Women Center of Palawan last March 29, 2022 at Bgy. Irawan, Puerto Princesa City. This is a special facility that caters vulnerable females, specifically those who were victims of abuse. The school conducted brief skills enhancement trainings – *Process Food by Sugar Concentration and Basics of Nail Services*.

The school also took part in Purple Fridays and online GAD activities. Last March 31, 2022, its GAD focal person attended the Orientation on GAD Plan and Tools, conducted via Zoom by the TESDA Region IV-B, with the resource person coming from TESDA Women Center. –LG
