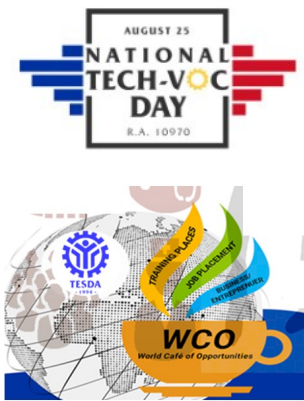


# TESDA Palawan holds hybrid World Café of Opportunities

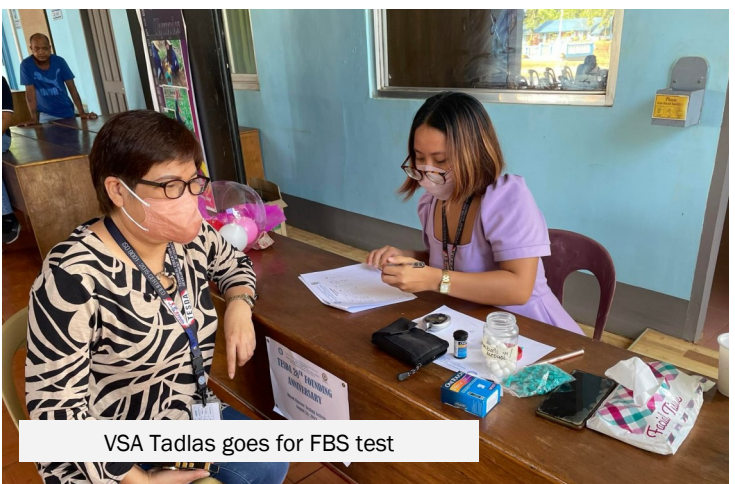

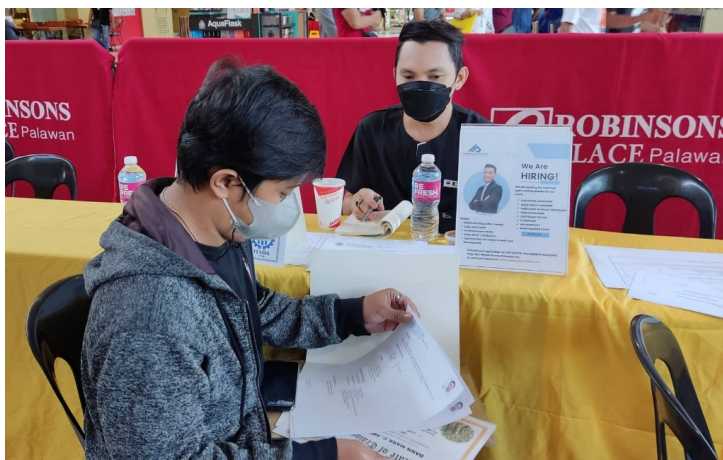
# World Café of Opportunities at Robinsons Place

Page 1 < formally declared the opening of the WCO in front of over 20 industry partners from the tourism, construction, transport and other business sectors. The alumni from the Puerto Princesa School of Arts and Trades (PPSAT), Provincial Training Center (PTC) and other private TESDA schools took part in the WCO. To facilitate employment among graduates in the municipalities, the PTC-Palawan also held a hybrid WCO in Roxas, Palawan.

Furthermore, to accommodate queries and concerns about matters related to working overseas, the TESDA Palawan also invited Jonathan Gerodias, provincial coordinator from the Department of Migrant Workers, and Ma. Lourdes Cabanillas, the administrative officer from the Philippine Overseas Employment Administration (POEA). The one-day WCO ended with special recognitions given to the participating companies and a closing speech from Dr. Patty Ortega, the President of TVI's Association of Palawan.
